- Killing

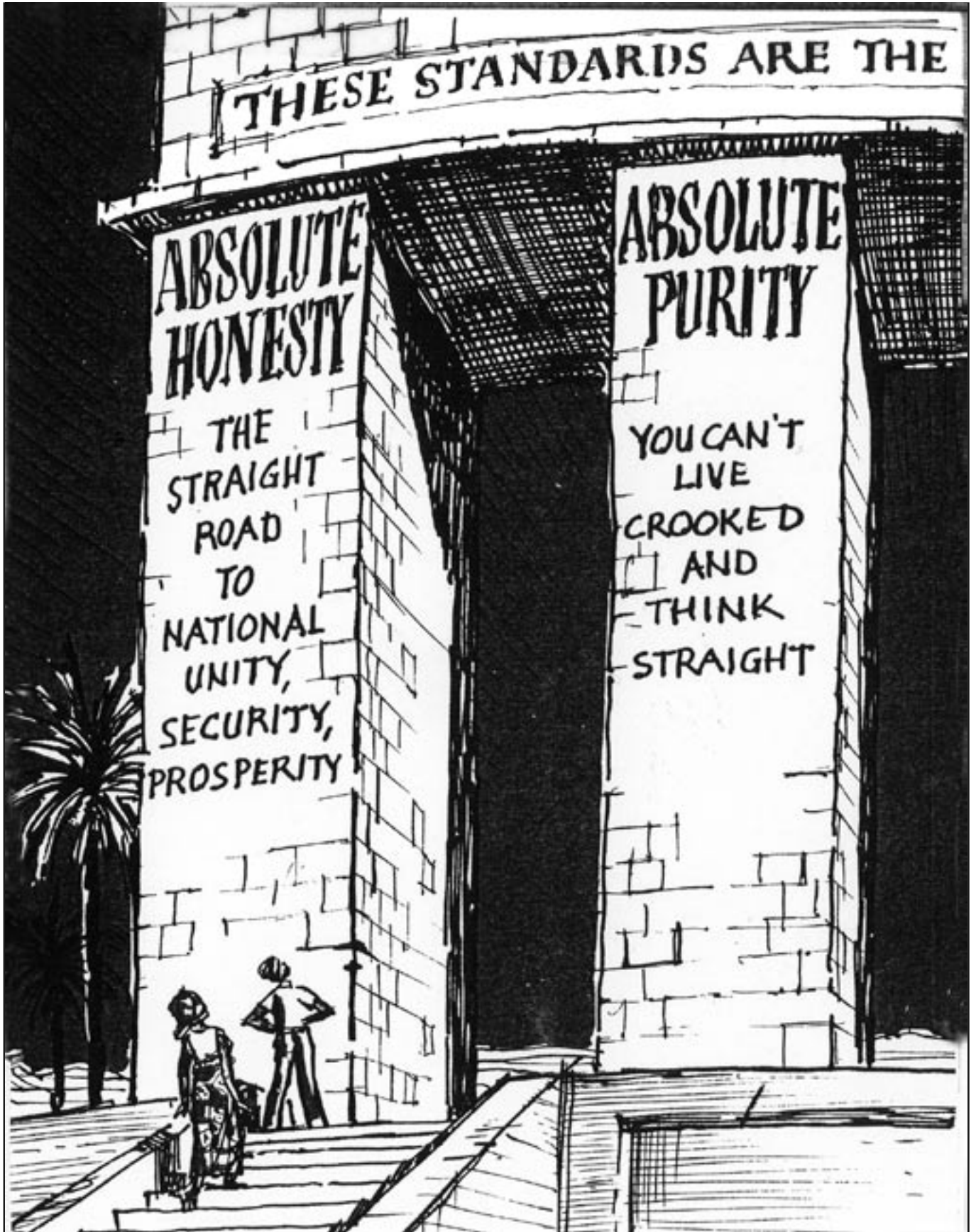


Men who are run by these motives cannot be trusted to give the needed leadership in national affairs or in any walk of life.

You can't make a good meal with rotten food. Nor a new country with rotten people.

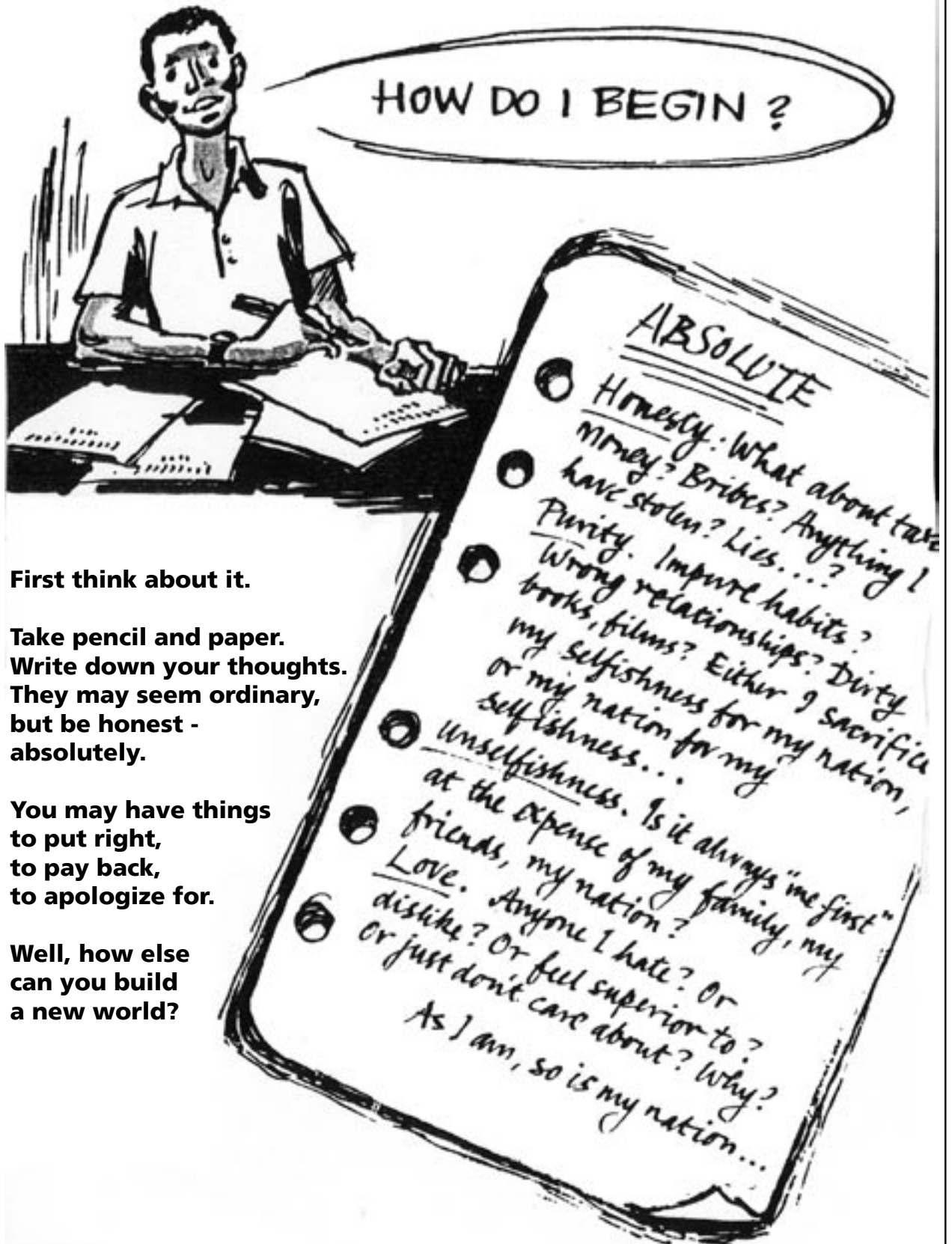

a new world?

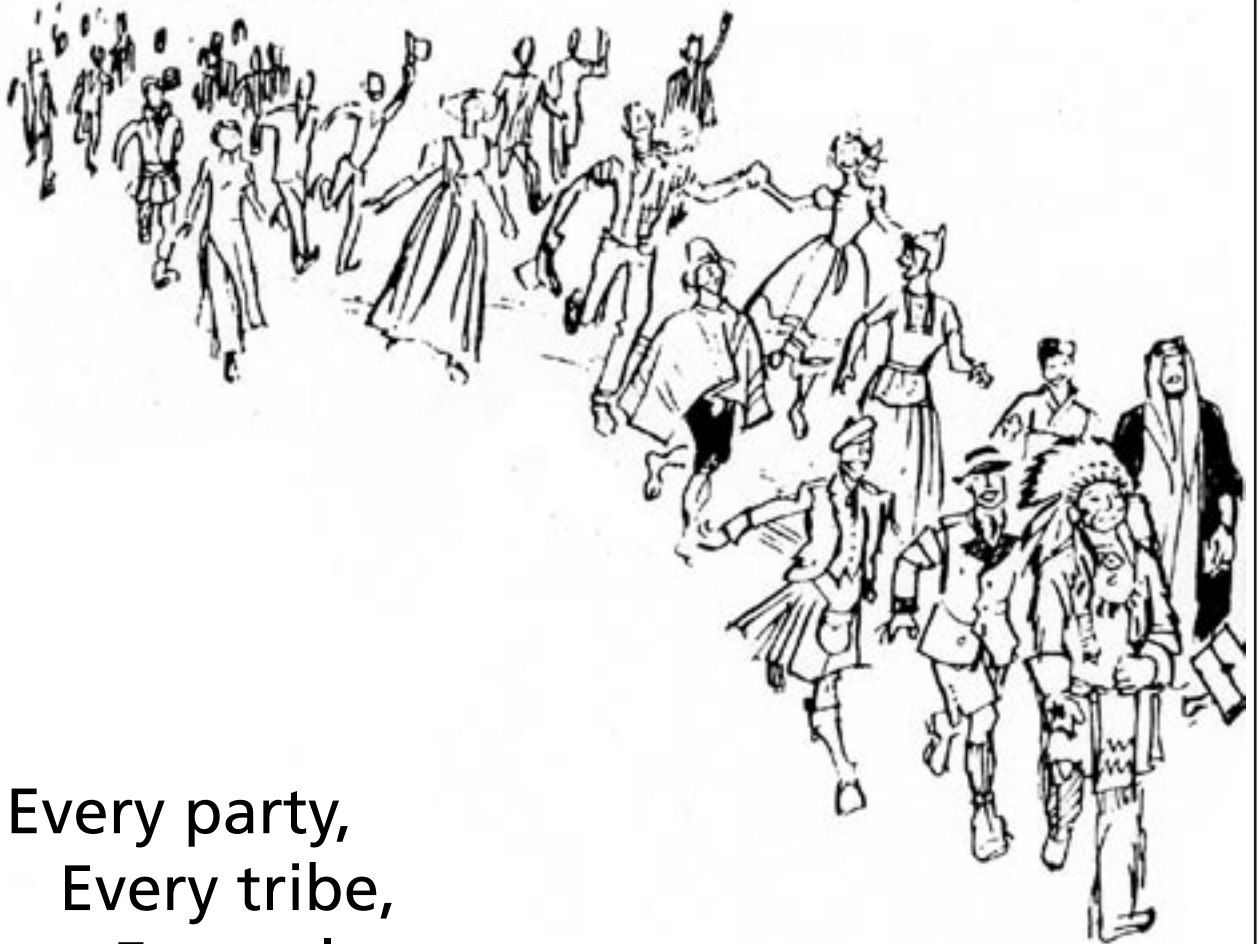
